Chair Anderson recognized Representative Tyler Olson for opening comments on [HSB 619](#). Representative T. Olson was recognized for opening comments on Amendment 3854. There being no discussion, Representative T. Olson was recognized for closing comments on Amendment 3854. Representative T. Olson moved passage of Amendment 3854. The amendment passed by a voice vote. Discussion on [HSB 619](#) as amended followed. There being no discussion, Representative T. Olson was recognized for closing comments on [HSB 619](#). Representative T. Olson moved [HSB 619](#) as amended. [HSB 619](#) passed the Judiciary Committee 19-0, with two absent, Representatives Wessel-Kroeschell and Swaim. Chair Anderson announced that [HSB 619](#), having received a constitutional majority would pass to the Floor of the House as a committee bill. Chair Anderson recognized Representative Rogers for opening comments on [HSB 512](#). Representative Rogers was recognized for opening comments on amendment 3581. Representative Rogers deferred to Representative Wolfe for opening comments on amendment 3581. Discussion on amendment 3581 followed. Representative Wolfe was recognized for closing comments on Amendment 3581. Representative Wolfe moved passage of Amendment 3581. The amendment passed by a voice vote. Representative Rogers was recognized for opening comments on amendment 3762. Discussion on amendment 3762 followed. Representative Rogers was recognized for closing comments on Amendment 3762. Representative Rogers moved [HSB 512](#). [HSB 512](#) passed the Judiciary Committee 19-1, with Representative Swaim being absent. The nay vote being cast by R. Olson. Chair Anderson announced that [HSB 512](#), having received a constitutional majority would pass to the Floor of the House as a committee bill. Chair Anderson recognized Representative Hagenow for opening comments on [HF 2004](#). Discussion on [HF 2004](#) followed. Representative Hagenow was recognized for closing comments on [HF 2004](#). Representative Hagenow moved [HF 2004](#). [HF 2004](#) failed to pass the Judiciary Committee with the vote being 10-10, with Representative Swaim being absent. Those voting nay were Representatives Wolfe, Gaines, Lensing, Oldson, Olson, R., Olson, T., Smith, Wessel-Kroeschell, Pearson, and Heaton. Chair Anderson announced that [HF 2004](#), not having received a constitutional majority would not pass to the Floor of the House. Chair Anderson recognized Representative Garrett for opening comments on [HF 2139](#). There being no discussion, Representative Garrett was recognized for closing comments on [HF 2139](#). Representative Garrett moved [HF 2139](#). [HF 2139](#) passed the Judiciary Committee 19-0, with two absent-Representatives Kaufmann and Swaim . Chair Anderson announced that [HF 2139](#), having received a constitutional majority would pass to the Floor of the House as a committee bill. Chairperson Anderson and Ranking Member Wolfe announced that they would be going to their respective caucuses until 4:00 PM. There being no further business to come before the committee, Representative Rogers moved to adjourn. The House Judiciary Committee adjourned at 3:30 P.M.
