Chair Sweeney called the meeting to order. Roll call was taken and a quorum was present.

With no additions or corrections to the 2/13 or 2/15 meeting minutes, the minutes were approved as distributed.

Chair Sweeney recognized Representative De Boef for opening comments on HF 481, an act relating to reimbursement for state audits of certain commodity organizations, and including effective date provisions. Representative De Boef moved HF 481, a record roll call was taken, and HF 481 passed moving the bill to the floor of the House as a committee bill, 23-0.

Chair Sweeney recognized Representative Deyoe for opening comments on HF 2092, an act providing for the year-round operation of farmers markets, and including effective date provisions. Representative Deyoe presented Amendment 4138 to HF 2092. Following discussion, voice vote passed Amendment 4138. Chair Sweeney recognized Representative Deyoe for closing comments on HF 2092 as amended. Representative Deyoe moved HF 2092 as amended, a record roll call was taken, and HF 2092 passed moving the bill to the floor of the House an individually sponsored bill, 23-0.

Chair Sweeney recognized Representative Moore for opening comments on HSB 618, a study bill relating to the assessment of moneys on sheep and wool production. Representative Moore presented Amendment 4104 to HSB 618. Following discussion, voice vote passed Amendment 4104. Chair Sweeney recognized Representative Moore for closing comments on HSB 618 as amended. Representative Deyoe moved HSB 618 as amended, a record roll call was taken, and HSB 618 passed moving the bill to the floor of the House a committee bill, 23-0.

With no further business to come before the committee, Representative Paustian moved to adjourn.
