Representative Raecker convened the Appropriations Committee meeting at 2:10 PM. Roll was called; quorum present. Minutes from the February 16, 2012 meeting were approved.

Both parties went to caucus at 2:12 PM.

Representative Raecker called the meeting back to order at 2:46 PM. The Chair requested and received unanimous consent to dissolve the committee into a subcommittee of the whole for consideration of HSB 661, an Act relating to appropriations for health and human services and including other related provisions and appropriations, and including effective, retroactive, and applicability date provisions. The Chair recognized Representative Heaton for opening remarks. Extensive questions and discussion followed in the subcommittee. Representative Heaton was then recognized for closing remarks, and moved HSB 661. HSB 661 passed, short form. Representative Raecker requested and received unanimous consent to dissolve the committee of the whole and return to the full committee. Representative Heaton was recognized for opening remarks; no further remarks were offered. Representative Olson was recognized for comment. Further discussion followed and Representative Heaton was then recognized for closing remarks on HSB 661. Representative Heaton moved the study bill, which passed 15-10.
