The House Judiciary Committee reconvened at 3:30 P.M. Chair Anderson recognized Representative Hagenow for opening comments on [SF 2208](#). Representative Hagenow was recognized for opening comments on Amendment 4947. There being no discussion, Representative Hagenow was recognized for closing comments on Amendment 4947. Representative Hagenow moved passage of Amendment 4947. The amendment passed by a voice vote. There being no further discussion, Representative Hagenow was recognized for closing comments on [SF 2208](#) as amended. Representative Hagenow moved [SF 2208](#) as amended. [SF 2208](#) passed the Judiciary Committee 20-0, with one absent, Representative Swaim. Chair Anderson announced that [SF 2208](#) having received a constitutional majority would pass to the Floor of the House as a Senate bill. Chair Anderson recognized Representative Taylor for opening comments on [SF 2296](#). Following discussion, Representative Taylor was recognized for closing comments on [SF 2296](#). Representative Taylor moved [SF 2296](#). [SF 2296](#) passed the Judiciary Committee 17-3, with one absent, Representative Swaim. The nay votes were cast by Representatives Wolfe, Gaines, and Olson, R. Chair Anderson announced that [SF 2296](#), having received a constitutional majority would pass to the Floor of the House as a Senate bill. Chair Anderson recognized Representative Garrett for opening comments on [SF 493](#). Representative Garrett was recognized for opening comments on Amendment 5056. There being no discussion, Representative Garrett was recognized for closing comments on Amendment 5056. The amendment

passed by a voice vote. Following discussion, Representative Garrett was recognized for closing comments on [SF 493](#) as amended. Representative Garrett moved [SF 493](#) as amended. [SF 493](#) passed the Judiciary Committee 20-0, with one absent, Representative Swaim. Chair Anderson announced that [SF 493](#), having received a constitutional majority would pass to the Floor of the House as a Senate bill. Chair Anderson recognized Vice Chair Baltimore as temporary chair. Chair Baltimore recognized Representative Anderson for opening comments on [SF 2295](#). Representative Anderson was recognized for Amendment 5072. Following discussion, Representative Anderson was recognized for closing comments on Amendment 5072. The amendment passed by a voice vote. There being no discussion, Representative Anderson was recognized for closing comments on [SF 2295](#) as amended. Representative Anderson moved [SF 2295](#) as amended. [SF 2295](#) passed the Judiciary Committee 20-0, with one absent, Representative Swaim. Chair Anderson announced that [SF 2295](#), having received a constitutional majority would pass to the Floor of the House as a Senate bill. Chair Baltimore relinquished the chair back to Representative Anderson. Chair Anderson recognized Representative Gaines for opening comments on [SF 2306](#). Following discussion, Representative Gaines was recognized for closing comments on [SF 2306](#). Representative Gaines moved [SF 2306](#). [SF 2306](#) passed the Judiciary Committee 20-0, with one absent, Representative Swaim. Chair Anderson announced that [SF 2306](#), having received a constitutional majority would pass to the Floor of the House as a Senate bill. There being no further business to come before the committee, Representative Baltimore made some closing comments and Representative Hagenow moved to adjourn. The House Judiciary Committee adjourned at 4:00 P.M.
