Chairman Representative Sands called the meeting to order at 1:32 PM. Attendance was taken and quorum was present.

Minutes from the March 29th meeting were approved.

Chairman Sands recognized Representative Soderberg for HSB 540. A study bill relating to city and county authority to address slum and blight and economic development by modifying Iowa's urban renewal law, providing for a future repeal of Iowa's urban renewal law, authorizing cities and counties to establish project development areas and to utilize tax increment financing for certain projects, and including effective date provisions. The Chair recognized Representative Soderberg for Amendment 5429. The Chair recognized Representative Soderberg for Amendment to the Amendment 5563. The amendment to the amendment was moved and passed on short form. The Chair asked for unanimous consent for a sense amendment to the amendment, adding the phrase "lines 1-7". This was indicated, but not clearly stated in Amendment 5429. Consent was granted and sense amendment passed. The amendment as amended was moved and passed on short form. Representative Soderberg moved the bill as amended. The bill as amended was moved and passed by the vote of 15 Aye to 10 The nay votes were Representatives Jacoby, Isenhart, Kajtazovic, Kearns, Muhlbauer, Oldson, Petersen, Quirk, Thomas and Willems. This bill as amended will move to the house floor as a Ways and Means Committee Bill.

Chairman Sands recognized Representative Cownie for HSB 671. An Act relating to early school start date provisions, establishing a waiver application fee, and including effective date and applicability provisions. The Chair recognized Representative Cownie for Amendment 5566. The amendment was moved and passed on short form.
