An Act relating to the income tax checkoffs for the child abuse prevention program fund and the veterans trust fund and volunteer fire fighter preparedness fund, and including retroactive applicability provisions. Representative Paustian moved the bill. The bill was moved and passed by the vote of 25 Aye to 0 Nay. This bill will move to the house floor as a Ways & Means committee bill.

Chairman Sands recognized Representative De Boef HF 2420. A bill for an act relating to department of public health programs and activities, providing for a penalty, and including effective and applicability date provisions. Representative De Boef moved the bill. The bill was moved and passed by the vote of 23 Aye to 2 Nay. The nay votes were Representatives Pettengill and Thomas. This bill will move to the house floor as a Ways and Means Committee Bill.
