Public Hearings

General Requirements:

Speaking time will be 2 minutes per individual and will alternate between pro/con for as long as possible, written testimony is encouraged but not required. The Public Hearing will last 60 minutes.

This Public Hearing will be held in person at the Iowa State Capitol, Room 103. If you sign up to speak, you must speak in person at the event.

Persons wishing to speak at the public hearing, must sign up electronically at [Public Hearing](#). The cut off to sign up to speak will be 6 a.m. on Tuesday, April 21, 2026.

Between 8:30 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. you will need to check in with the event coordinator by Room 103, you must be checked in prior to the public hearing starting.

The meeting will be live streamed via YouTube. The link to the meeting will be provided one hour (60 minutes) prior to the start of the meeting on [Iowa Legislative website](#).
