## General Requirements:

Keep in mind the public hearing is for 60 minutes, depending on the length of each speaker not to exceed 2 minutes per person between 30 and 40 speakers will be heard during the public hearing.

Thirty minutes prior to the start of the meeting, you will need to check in with the event coordinator by Room 103, you must be checked in prior to the public hearing starting.
