

CHAPTER 6
CONTESTED CASES

The foundation has adopted the contested case provisions of the Uniform Administrative Rules which are printed in the first volume of the Iowa Administrative Code with the following amendments:

851—6.1(17A) Scope and applicability. In lieu of the words “(agency name)”, insert “Wallace Technology Transfer Foundation”.

851—6.2(17A) Definitions. In lieu of the words “(designate official)”, insert “the president of the foundation or such other presiding officer as the board may designate by resolution to hear the contested case and issue a proposed decision”. In lieu of the words “(agency name)”, insert “Wallace Technology Transfer Foundation”.

851—6.25(17A) Final decision. In lieu of the words “(the agency) (or a quorum of the agency)”, insert “the board”.

6.25(2) In lieu of the words “(agency name)”, insert “board”.

851—6.26(17A) Appeals and review.

6.26(2) Review. In lieu of the words “(board, commission, director)”, insert “board”.

6.26(3) Requests to present additional evidence. Delete the words “(or other time period designated by the agency)”. In lieu of the words “(board, commission, director)”, insert “board”.

6.26(4) Scheduling. In lieu of the words “(agency name)”, insert “board”.

6.26(5) Briefs and arguments. Delete the words “(or other time period designated by the agency)”. In lieu of the words “(board, commission, director)”, insert “board”.

851—6.27(17A) Applications for rehearing. In lieu of the words “(agency name)” and “(board, commission, director)”, insert “board”.

These rules are intended to implement Iowa Code sections 15E.152 to 15E.166 and Iowa Code chapter 17A.
