

CHAPTER 6
DECLARATORY RULINGS

[Prior to 4/22/87, see Banking Department[140] Ch 3]

The Iowa division of banking hereby adopts the declaratory rulings segment of the Uniform Administrative Rules which is printed in the first Volume of the Iowa Administrative Code with the following amendments.

187—6.1(17A) Petition for declaratory ruling. In lieu of the words “the agency at (designate of-fice)” insert “the Superintendent of Banking, Iowa Department of Commerce, Division of Banking, 200 East Grand Avenue, Suite 300, Des Moines, Iowa 50309-1827”. In lieu of the words “(AGENCY NAME)” the heading on the petition should read:

BEFORE THE DIVISION OF BANKING
