### DEAD.

**McKAY**—At the residence of Alex McKay, in Decorah, Thursday, May 12th, John McKay, of Madison township, aged 53 years 5 months and 2 days.

John McKay was born in Mt. Morris, N. Y., Dec. 10th, 1838. In 1854 he came to Iowa with his parents who settled in this county. For twenty-five years and until some three years ago he was on the Mississippi river, as a pilot on raft boats. The life there was one of exposure, and he contracted an illness which caused his death. Realizing that he could not follow his vocation for many years to come he retired to the old homestead in Madison twp., where he remained until six weeks ago, when his brother, Alex. McKay, brought him to Decorah to spend his last days with him. His death was sudden, but not entirely unexpected. Before going to his shop in the morning Mr. McKay asked him if there was anything he wanted, and he said there was not. Ten minutes later Mrs. McKay went in to see him and found him lying half out of bed and dead. Death had seemingly come to him without a struggle. The funeral services were held Saturday morning, and the remains taken to Bluffton for burial.

**WILLIAMS**—At his home near Hesper, Iowa, May 10, 1892, Hon. H. B. Williams, aged nearly seventy years.

Mr. Williams was born in Batavia, N. J., Sept. 22, 1822, and in 1837 he and two brothers went to Ingham Co., Mich., where he remained twenty years. While in Michigan Mr. Williams was engaged in the lumber business and in a flouring mill, and later entered the mercantile business. He afterward was admitted to practice and opened a law office, remaining in the same until 1857. After traveling through Dakota, Nebraska and Iowa he located in Hesper in 1858, and on Dec. 31st, 1860, was married to Caroline Tabor, daughter of Russel Tabor. Mrs. Williams died in June, 1881, leaving three daughters and three sons, all of whom are living and were permitted to attend the funeral on the 12th inst. In many ways Mr. Williams was a man of more than ordinary ability, he having represented his district in the 8th, 9th, 10th and 11th sessions. He was also a member of the legal profession in this state, having been admitted when he first came here. Mr. Williams took a lively interest in horticulture and landscape gardening, as was attested by the beauty of the grounds about his residence. He also took an interest in literary pursuits, having been an active member of the Hesper Reading Circle and also of the Philomathean Library Association. The children who are bereft of an indulgent father have the sympathy of the entire community, and none but those who have been thus afflicted can appreciate the gratitude which they feel toward those who have kindly assisted them during their time of trouble. ### ORDINANCE No. 24.

An Ordinance to repeal section No. 1, of Ordinance No. 23, of the incorporated town of West Decorah, in relation to restraining stock from running at large within the limits of said town.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the incorporated town of West Decorah, Iowa:

**SECTION 1.** That section 1 of Ordinance No. 23, and the same is hereby repealed, and the following enacted in lieu thereof. No horses, mules, cattle, sheep, swine or geese shall be allowed to run at large within the incorporated limits of the town of West Decorah.

**SECTION 2.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with the above are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on and after its publication as provided by law.

as at home. As evidence of this fact, the reader is referred to his appointment as Chairman of the Judiciary Committee.

The following persons have been elected to represent the county in the State Legislature :

Knudt Bergh and Warren Danforth, 1871.

Knudt Bergh was born in Norway, and came to America when a boy, with his father, and settled in Highland township. Mr. Bergh early appreciated the value of an education, and strove with all his energy to attain the high place he afterward reached in educational circles. An adopted citizen, he became an American in all that the name implies. He was an exemplary man, and revered by all who knew him. In the legislative halls of the state he served his county with fairness and ability.

Mr. Bergh was a graduate of the University of St. Louis. He afterward became one of the professors in the Norwegian Lutheran College. His health failed him, and in 1873 he visited his native country, where he died of consumption, on the 16th of June, 1875, at Eide, Hardanger, Norway.

James B. Brown and H. B. Williams were elected in 1865.

H. B. Williams and J. T. Atkins were elected 1867.

H. B. Williams and O. A. Lomen were elected in 1869.

Warren Danforth and John DeCow, 1873.

Warren Danforth and M. N. Johnson, 1875.

M. N. Johnson, born in Racine County, Wisconsin, March 3, 1850, immigrated to Winneshiek County, Iowa, the same spring. He attended the public schools, fitted himself for college at the Upper Iowa University, and graduated in class '73, at the Iowa State University. He also graduated in the law class of '76, at the same institution. He entered politics in the fall of 1875, and was elected by the Republicans to the the State Legislature. He was elected Presidential elector in 1876.
