V. B. CROOKS, who came here in the late 50's, was a successful lawyer, possessed of more than average ability. He gave Jefferson its first newspaper. His death occurred before the war, while in his prime. In politics he was a democrat.

H. C. RIPPEY, a cousin of Judge R. M. Rippey, emigrated from Elkhart, Indiana, to this county, and practiced law in this city for a number of years, and then removed to Florida. He was a democrat, but during the war acted with the republicans. His ability and earnest union sentiments gave him a term in the legislature.

G. S. TOLIVER commenced the practice of law in Jefferson soon after his return from the army in 1864, and has continued to the present time, being the oldest practitioner, by far, in the county. Possibly an exception should be made for the two terms of service he gave as county treasurer and one term as member of the Iowa state legislature. In 1870 he formed a partnership alliance with John J. Russell, and the firm enjoyed a large and lucrative practice until the death of Mr. R. in 1901. For a few years last past Mr. Toliver has given over the more strenuous lines of court practice, and finds plenty of employment in looking after his land and loan interests, the management of estates and as consulting counsel, as his thorough knowledge of law invests his conclusions with special value. He has an elegant home in this city, and is in a position to enjoy life at its best. Politically he is a republican.

ALBERT HEAD came to Jefferson soon after the close of the Civil war, bringing from the army ranks a captain's commission. For several years he practiced law and engaged in the real estate business, with J. J. Russell as a legal partner for part of the time. Later he devoted himself to banking, which, in connection with buying and selling land, has engrossed his attention ever since, if exception may be made of time spent in politics and traveling. He served five terms as a member of the legislature

from Greene county, and was speaker of the house during the session of 1887. In politics he is a republican. He is connected with the Greene County National Bank as its chief proprietor.

JOHN J. RUSSELL easily ranks as the ablest lawyer in the entire list of Greene county members of the bar. His readings were thorough, and he was gifted with quick, accurate insight and good forms of speech. A good judge of human nature, he knew how to handle a witness or a jury in order that they subserve the best interests of his clients. He won out in cases where less resourceful men would have stood appalled at the hopelessness of their contention. He came to Jefferson on borrowed capital, and his locating here was an accident, he having been persuaded to stop off while en route for Denison by Mahlon Head, to inquire into the desirability of a law partnership with Albert Head, who had recently located here. This alliance was effected, and Mr. Russell spent the remainder of his life as a resident of Jefferson. Following this partnership with Mr. Head he was alone for a time in practice, and then formed a partnership with Mr. G. S. Toliver, with whom he was intimately and continuously associated until the time of his death, in 1901. He served two terms in the state senate, representing Greene, Carroll and Sac counties. President Grant gave him a place on the Ute Indian commission, which he held during its entire term of service. Originally he was a republican, but disagreeing with his party on the prohibition and the tariff questions, he ignored strenuous politics during the later years of his life. His death was very sudden, and deeply deplored by the people of the county. As a lawyer he achieved remarkable success and as a financier he was specially identified with the City Bank.

ORLANDO H. MANNING read law with Russell & Head, practiced law at Jefferson for a time, where his parents resided, and then moved to Carroll. That county sent him to the legislature, and, recognizing his ability, the republicans of the state made him lieutenant-gov-
