**Obituary.**

Rev. Henry Wharton died at his residence in this city, between three and four o'clock Wednesday afternoon. Deceased was born in Wheeling county, Virginia, November 9th, 1799. He removed thence to Muskingum county, Ohio, in 1832, where he remained until 1853 when he became a resident of Iowa and lived in that State twenty-two years, during which time he was four times elected a member of the Legislature. In 1875 he came to this State and has since made Gridley his home. Ordained at the age of twenty-five, for upwards of fifty years he was a circuit-riding in the interest of Methodism. During his residence in this community he frequently officiated. His last sermon was delivered about a year ago. Since that time his extreme age has prevented him from occupying the pulpit. The immediate cause of death was dropsy. He was a man of rare intellect and remarkable scholarly attainments. His mind was unusually active up to the time of his death and his memory was more reliable than that of many persons half his age. Deceased leaves a family of grown-up children and a wife nearly 80 years of age to mourn his loss. The funeral took place yesterday and was very largely attended. A good man has been called home; his influence was always used in the cause of right, and we cannot doubt that the Master greeted his spirit with "Well done, good and faithful servant."






