

John G. Myerly, 81, of 3017 High st., veteran Des Moines attorney, died Wednesday night at Iowa Methodist hospital of a complication of diseases.


Mr. Myerly entered the hospital Nov. 11. He maintained an office in the Bankers Trust building. The body was taken to Dunn's Funeral home.


