KENNAN CASE TO THE JURY

Attorneys Finished Arguments
and Case Went to Jury
3:00 p. m.—Much Interest
in Outcome.

Taking of testimony in the case of J. A. Kennan vs. the U. S. Railway Administration was completed Friday forenoon, and R. S. Milner made the opening argument for the plaintiff before the jury after dinner. He was followed by Judge Burnham for the defense. After Mr. Burnham had finished court was adjourned until Monday morning of this week.

During Friday the case was heard by but eleven jurors, Frank Severin of Van Horne, having been called home Thursday night by the illness and subsequent death of a daughter, Mrs. J. E. Thompson. He received a telephone message Thursday afternoon stating that his daughter was very low, but did not ask to be excused until court adjourned at five o'clock. By an agreement of both parties the case was continued without Mr. Severin.

Monday the case was heard by but ten jurors, F. S. Bender being unable to report for duty on account of illness. The ten jurors who remained to arrive at a verdict were: A. H. Jacobsen, J. O. Chesley, Wm. Donahue, J. W. Seeman, Elbert Yerkes, Ed O'Brien, C. A. Bunker, Jim J. Rice, Virge Self and Ad Lupton.

MALCOLM F. McNIE

DIED IN CALIFORNIA

Malcolm F. McNie, one of the pioneer residents of Harrison township, died Thursday night at Long Beach, Calif. His death was sudden, and was due to an attack of heart trouble. News of his death was received by his son, Arthur McNie, of Harrison township, Friday forenoon. That night Mr. McNie and his two brothers, Robert of Vinton, Colo., and Morris of Hampton, left for Long Beach, Calif., to attend the funeral.

Mr. McNie was about seventy-two years of age. He was a native of New York, but came to Benton county with his parents, when he was about eight years of age. He became one of the prominent men of this locality and represented Benton county in the legislature in the 29th, 30th and 31st general assemblies. Eleven years ago he and his wife moved to Long Beach, Calif., which city has since been their home, and at which place interment will be made.

Mr. McNie had been bothered with his heart before going to California, but had been much better since, and was apparently in good health up to the hour of his death. He is survived by his wife and the three sons mentioned above. His death will be a matter of genuine sorrow to the many old friends in Vinton and vicinity.
