HERMAN KULL, FORMER STATE LEGISLATOR, DIES IN WISCONSIN SATURDAY

Funeral Services Held in Lake Geneva Yesterday Afternoon

Herman Kull, 77, of Cresco, former Howard county representative in the Iowa state legislature, died Saturday in the home of his brother, Grover Kull, near Lake Geneva, Wisconsin.

Mr. Kull had been in failing health for sometime but was not seriously ill until only recently when he and Mrs. Kull had to conclude a winter spent in Florida to return to Lake Geneva.

Funeral services for Mr. Kull were held yesterday afternoon from a Lake Geneva funeral home. The Rev. Mr. Schowalter conducted the services, and burial was in the Oak Hill cemetery, at Lake Geneva. Attending the services from Cresco were Mr. and Mrs. C. H. Moen and Mr. and Mrs. Ernest Peter.

Mr. Kull was born March 14, 1876, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Andrew Kull of Bloomfield, Walworth county, Wisconsin. He was graduated from the Lake Geneva high school, and while still a young man he joined the Lake Geneva Congregational church.

He was married in 1900 to Jessie Arnold and following their marriage Mr. and Mrs. Kull moved to a farm near Cresco where they lived for 20 years. They then retired and moved to Cresco.

Mr. Kull was elected to the Iowa state legislature and served three terms. He was a member of the
