## CHARLES W. HUFF DIES TUESDAY MORNING AUGUST 28

Charles W. Huff, long time resident of Massena township and prominent political figure in Cass County, died in his sleep Tuesday morning. He had been in failing health for several years.

Mr. Huff, the son of Capt. and Mrs. C. W. Huff, was born in October, 1874 on a farm northeast of Anita. The family later moved to the homestead northeast of Massena where he made his home with his brother-in-law and sister, Mr. and Mrs. Geo. Sease. He was married to Fannie Lowe of Atlantic, who preceded him in death in 1917. He was also preceded in death by a brother and two sisters, Mrs. Rowena Harris of Massena and Mrs. Delpha Smith of Denver Colo. Surviving are four sisters, Mrs. George Sease, Massena; Mrs. Blanche Comer and Mrs. Art Harper of Long Beach Calif., and Mrs. Laura Smith of Crystal Lake, Ill.

Mr. Huff served several terms as Cass county recorder and also as State Representative from this district.

Funeral services are being held this afternoon, (Thursday, August 30) at 2 P. M. at the Methodist church in Massena with Rev. Joseph Mason officiating. Burial will be in Massena Township cemetery.
