Carl Sass

Carl W. H. Sass, 95, 715 38th St., longtime Sloux City attorney, died Thursday in a Sloux City hospital after a brief illness.

Services will be at 1 p.m. Saturday in Meyer Bros. Colonial Chapel. The Rev. Jay Atkinson, pastor of the First Unitarian Church, will officiate. A Masonic service will be conducted by Landmark Lodge 103, AF&AM, following the services. Burial will be in Logan Park Cemetery.

Mr. Sass was born April 19, 1888, in Sloux City. He attended Sloux City elementary schools and was graduated from Sloux City High School. He was graduated from Morningside College in 1915 with a B.A. degree and from the University of Chicago Law School in 1919 with a juris doctor degree.

He married Delberta Edgington Dec. 28, 1929, in Sloux City. She died Feb. 20, 1954, in Sloux City. He was a justice of the peace for eight years and served a session in the Iowa Legislature beginning in 1929. He practiced law in Sloux City until 1981.

Mr. Sass was a member of the First Unitarian Church and Monahan Post 64, American Legion. He had been a member of Landmark Lodge 103, AF&AM, since 1909 and served as master in 1923. He also was a member of the Sloux City Consistory, Abu Bekr Shrine Temple and 33rd Degree (Honorary). He was an officer in the field artillery during World War I.

Survivors include two stepdaughters, Viola E. Bland of Denison, Iowa and Carol E. Thornton of Des Moines; five stepgrandchildren and 11 stepgreat-grandchildren.

A memorial has been established in his name with the Shrine Crippled Children's Hospital.


