Curtis McKinnon Funeral Today In Los Angeles, Calif.

Curtis L. McKinnon, 67, died suddenly in his home at 2496 Leo Ave., Los Angeles, Calif. Monday evening from a coronary heart attack. He had prepared a dinner in the evening for his family on the patio and shortly after eating he suffered the attack.


Funeral services will be held there at two o'clock Thursday afternoon. He is survived by his widow, the former Emma Meade of Morning Sun, also one son, Ralph and a daughter, Mrs. Muriel Pulman, five grandchildren, all living in California.

Mr. McKinnon was born in New London October 10, 1889, the son of Emma Morrow and John Q. McKinnon. He was educated in the public schools and was in business and farmed south of New London on the Lowell road.

During the depression years he became active in politics and was elected to the state legislature serving in the 45th and 46th general assembly. In the primary election in 1932 he opposed Gilbert Garretson on the democratic ticket and won 740 to 443. In the general election that fall he defeated the late Dr. J. W. Laird, regular Republican candidate, Harlan Foster, Independent. The vote was McKinnon 3607, Laird 2263 and Foster 1912. He was a state leader opposing testing of cattle for T.B. In 1934 for the second term he defeated the late A. M. Van Allen, Mt. Pleasant attorney, by 400 votes. By the time he returned for the second term he had been recognized as a powerful politician in the democratic party and was frequently mentioned for governor. Gov. Clyde Herring appointed him to the highway commission where he later served as chairman. His term expired in 1939.

CURTIS L. MCKINNON

MR. SPEAKER: Your committee, appointed to prepare a suitable resolution commemorating the life, character and public service of the late Honorable Curtis L. McKinnon, begs leave to submit the following memorial:

Curtis L. McKinnon was born in New London, Iowa, October 10, 1889, the son of Emma (Morrow) and John Q. McKinnon. He died at his home in Los Angeles, California, August 19, 1957.

Mr. McKinnon married Emma Meade of Morning Sun and they had two children, a son Ralph and a daughter Muriel.

Mr. McKinnon was educated in the public schools of Henry County. He farmed south of New London on the Lowell road and had other business interests.

Mr. McKinnon served in the Forty-fifth and Forty-sixth General Assemblies of the State of Iowa. He was a Democrat. While serving his second term, Governor Clyde L. Herring appointed him to the Highway Commission which he later served as chairman. His term expired in 1939.

He then became a salesman for road machinery and continued in this business and lived in New London. Due to his wife's health they moved to Arizona in 1944. Remaining there for two years, they moved to California in 1946.

Surviving him are his widow, his son Ralph and daughter, Mrs. Muriel Pohlman, also five grandchildren, all living in California.

Therefore, Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the Sixty-first General Assembly of Iowa: That in the passing of the Honorable Curtis L. McKinnon the state has lost an honored citizen and a faithful and useful public servant, and the House by this resolution would express its appreciation of his service, and tender its sympathy to the members of his family.

Be It Further Resolved: That a copy of this resolution be spread upon the Journal of the House and that the Chief Clerk be directed to forward an enrolled copy to the family of the deceased.
