Federal Land Bank Association Meeting Feb. 12

Invitations have been mailed to 400 stockholders of the Federal Land Bank Association of Chariton to attend the annual meeting to be held at 1 p.m., Friday, February 12. This was announced today by Theo N. Hoegh, manager of the Chariton farmer-owned long-term credit cooperative.

According to Mr. Hoegh, the meeting will begin promptly at 1 p.m. in the Ritz Theater in Chariton and will be adjourned by 2:50 p.m. The program provides for: (1) Over \$400 in prizes, gifts and souvenirs; (2) free motion pictures as follows: "Brussels World's Fair", "What Is a Farm Worth", "Soil Bank Program", etc.

A short business session will call for the election of one association director and reports on dividends & progress according to Manager Hoegh. About 600 farmers and wives from Lucas and Wayne counties are expected to attend, he said.

ion dollars to complete the state highway program, this fiscal year. Federal public works projects already started will require expenditure of about \$8 billion. The federal government is committed to tribute \$6 billion in the next year for public housing. Merit Marine subsidies and ship placement constitute a responsibility of \$4.4 billion, and a variety of other obligations, when added to huge expended balances in the department, total \$98 billion commitments for future expenditures.

For 1961 alone, "built-in-increase" in outer space, civil aviation, merchant shipping, urban renewal, science education, medical research, public assistance loans to underdeveloped countries and veterans programs amount to between \$2 and \$3 billion.

Furthermore, our national debt, as noted above, does not include present federal liability for past services. Our already accrued liability for military retirement is about \$30 billion. Our unfunded present account for retirement benefits for civilian government employees \$27.5 billion. On top of future pensions and compensation for veterans will cost a \$300 billion. All of these factors add to the almost incredible total of \$750 billion. There is prospect that this annual budget will rise above the \$80 billion mark to between 90 and 100 billion dollars.

Uncle Sam's credit card account has us about \$750 billion in check.


