Free Clinic For Good Health

Residents of the Jewell community
60 or older are invited to attend a
free clinic for physical assessment.
Public Health Nursing Service of
Hilton County will hold a clinic on
September 13, 1979 at a site to be
announced later.

This service is intended to screen
senior individuals for early
detection of illness. As the name
implies, those senior citizens who
consider themselves in good health
will see a physician primarily for

acute illness are the candidates
sought for the clinic. The screening
consists of a simple blood test
(Hematocrit), urinalysis and a
complete physical assessment by the
public health nurses. If a problem is
detected, the client will be referred to
his own physician for diagnosis.


