The breakfast is free to "fly-ins" with a charge of 50 cents for "drive-ins."


Program co-chairmen for the C of C are Clifton Mealey and Robert E. Anderson.

Review Board Session Starts Here May 1

Objectors Must File Complaints By Monday, 20th

This year's field assessing work in Montgomery county, forming the basis for taxes paid in 1964, is being completed and the annual session of the Montgomery county board of review will begin at the courthouse here Wednesday, May 1; at 9 a.m. County Assessor Donald L. McCrory of Red Oak said the first hour of the board of review session Wednesday will be devoted to reorganization, but that property owners with objections could meet with the board after 10 a.m.

Board of review members are Ira S. Hartman of Elliott, W. E. Johnson of Red Oak, R. G. Mullen of Stanton and Maurice Wendling and A. C. Peterson, both Villisca.

Property owners with objection to the assessed valuation placed upon their property, or properties, must file their complaints in writing with the board of review not later than Monday, May 20, McCrory reminds. The written protests must be on forms obtained from the county assessor's office.

Board of review sessions will start daily at 9 a.m. until work is completed. They meet at the assessor's office at the courthouse and the session is held only during May.

Rural Fire Tax Levy Election

For Washington Township May 6

VILLISCA—Voters in Washington township, north and west of Villisca, will go to the polls Monday, May 6, for a special issue election involving the adoption of a rural fire protection levy.

Polls open at 8 a.m. at the Scioia church and will remain open until 8 p.m., with 60 per cent approval needed for adoption.

The basis for the proposal, which has been approved in portions of all the surrounding townships, call for an equal share of payment for rural fire protection and funds to upgrade equipment for this use.

In last year's election, the rural fire levy was approved in Valley township (Page county), East township, Douglas and Scott townships of Montgomery county. Villisca's fire department receives funds from the above townships with Nodaway township (Taylor county), planning to petition into the area very soon. With voters approval May 6, Washington would then join this group, with fire protection supplied by the local fire department.

New Rural Truck

Villisca Fire Chief Bruce Marsh, has noted that the department is in great need of a new rural truck, with an estimated fully-equipped cost of between \$9,000-\$12,000. Available funds of the local company is approximately \$2,500 (including trade-in of old truck) and it is estimated that a 1-mill levy for two years would completely cover the cost. The action states the drainage district assessments, and legal obligations and the special assessments are collectible.

The bonds will be used in financing drainage district work, including river straightening, by Wilbert Nielsen Construction Co. of Omaha, under contract awarded by the supervisors in the amount of \$30,187.50.

In a Friday action, the board of supervisors set Wednesday, May 15, at 10 a.m. at the courthouse for public hearing on a proposal to issue drainage district bonds in the amount of \$22,000.

He died Sunday, April 28, at the Cottage rest home, Red Oak, after a lengthy illness. He was a retired farmer.

The Rev. Carl Rayburn and the Rev. Douglas Witt officiate at the services and burial will be in the Grant cemetery. Arrangements are in charge of the Wolfe Funeral home, Villisca.

The son of Leander and Henrietta Stinemates, he was born April 22, 1877, near Grant and was married in 1900 to the former Edith V. Conrad of near Grant, who survives.

He was a member of the Grant Methodist church and had served as church trustee and Sunday school superintendent. He was a Mason and former school board member here. He had served four terms as a Montgomery county supervisor and two terms as state representative for Montgomery county.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by a son, Harold, Grant; a daughter, Mrs. Earl Spiker, Grant; two grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.
