Herman W. Walter, 73, 330 N. 1st St., longtime Council Bluffs attorney, died Wednesday at a Council Bluffs hospital.

Walter had entered the hospital Dec. 12, underwent gall bladder surgery Dec. 13, and later developed medical complications, Tracy McCurdy of McCurdy Funeral Home said.

Walter, whose son Craig is a former state representative, received his law degree from the University of Nebraska at Lincoln and began his 40-year career as a Council Bluffs attorney. He was active in his practice in the Park Building until his illness.


Walter was a former Iowa Assistant Attorney General and served five terms as Iowa GOP state representative in the 1940's.

He was a past president of the Pottawattamie County Bar Association; had served on the Council Bluffs Airport Commission; was a member of the Downtown Kiwanis Club; Bookfellows; Historical Society of Pottawattamie County; and the Iowa Thoroughbred Race Horse Association.

His wife, Audrey, died March 11, 1982.

Surviving are two sons, Craig D. of West Des Moines and Kim S. of Council Bluffs; brother, Richard Walter of Council Bluffs; and two grandchildren.

Funeral services will be 11 a.m. Saturday at McCurdy Funeral home.

OAKLAND — The death of Dennis Reiff, 21, of Oakland, which occurred at his home on New Year's Day was due to a self-inflicted gunshot wound to the head, according to authorities.


