"The completeness and accuracy of this important agricultural census depend upon each individual filling out the report form received," said Orvin Wilkie, Chief of the Bureau's Agriculture Division. "I am sure farmers and agricultural leaders want their county and State totals to be as accurate and useful as possible."

The farm census is the only government or private method for gathering and reporting agriculture information on a county-by-county basis for the entire Nation.
