Lyle Musmaker of Greenfield Dies

GREENFIELD—J. Lyle Musmaker, 61, prominent Greenfield attorney, former state senator, and former mayor of Greenfield, died at the Greater Community hospital in Creston Saturday night. He had been ill for several months, suffering from cancer of the lymph gland.

Funeral services will be held at St. John's Catholic church in Greenfield at 9:30 a. m. Tuesday. Rev. Fr. Bart Kane will officiate. Burial will be in the Greenfield cemetery. The Rosary will be said at the Bickford-Murray funeral home in Greenfield at 8 p. m. tonight.

Mr. Musmaker had practiced law in Greenfield with his father, the late George D. Musmaker, after receiving his bachelor of arts degree from Notre Dame university and his law degree from the State University of Iowa. He had carried on the practice after the death of his father in 1953.

He had filled an unexpired term in the state senate in 1947. He also had served on the state World war II bonus board. He was a former Adair county Republican chairman.

He was a veteran of military service in World wars I and II. He was a former vice commander of the Iowa department of the American Legion and a former seventh district Legion commander.

He is survived by his widow, Helen; a daughter, Jean Ann, at home; three brothers, George of Greenfield, Louis of Oakland, Calif., and Richard of Fort Dix, N. J.; and a sister, Mrs. Mary Louise Beck of Fontanelle.

Three Men Die In Auto Crash

Three men died in two traffic accidents on Iowa highways. Two of the victims were killed in a one-car crash.

Louis J. Klein, 20, of Ashton, driver of a car which struck a bridge on Highway 33 one mile north of Ashton, died in a City hospital Sunday of injuries suffered in the accident.

Mathew J. Jonas, 26, of Ashton, a passenger in the car, killed in the crash Saturday night.

Bud Crotty, 39, of Harlan, died Saturday night when his car in which he was riding struck a semi-trailer truck on the east edge of Webster City.

The driver of the car, W. H. Harris, 38, of Iowa Falls, the truck driver, Norman J. of Waterloo, were not seriously injured.

Another Iowan, Kenneth Hill, 23, of Cherokee, killed on Highway 50 about 10 miles east of Yankton, when the car he was driving collided with another car. Hill, a Yankton baker, was driving to Cherokee to spend the weekend with his wife and four children.

Up to 10 inches of new snow was left in parts of Iowa today by the weekend storm which swirled over the state. In many areas driving conditions were reported hazardous.

Cold

The cleanup work progressed in below-zero or near-zero temperatures.

Atlantic reported an overnight low of 14 degrees below zero. Sioux City had a 7 below and other readings ranged up to 5 above at Dubuque.

The weather bureau foresees a week for earmuffs and mittens. It said temperatures will average 10 to 15 degrees below normal at least until Saturday. Light snow was in prospect for Tuesday.

The weekend storm left 10 inches of snow at Steamboat Rock and Eldora. Des Moines and many other cities reported up to 6 inches of new snow, to top a still-thick cover from a storm week before last.

Another heavy snowstorm left an extensive blanket of white across the midwest today but it appeared to have lost most of its punch as it moved into the snow-covered north-east.

Lighter

Snow continued during the night in the Great Lakes region and the upper Ohio Valley but falls were light.

The snow belt spread eastward across Ohio, Pennsylvania, northern Virginia, Maryland and western New York.
