Henry William Siefkas, 83, died at the Clarke County Public Hospital in Osceola on Thursday, February 26, 1981. Funeral services were held from the Webster-Kate Funeral Home in Osceola on Saturday, February 28, with Pastor James Hampton of Murray officiating at the 2:30 p.m. rites. Interment was in Murray Cemetery.

Henry William Siefkas was born August 27, 1897, in Clarke County near Lacelle, son of R.F. Siefkas and Hannah Henrichs Siefkas. He attended schools in Clarke County and on May 18, 1922, was married to Eula Kelley in Clarke County. Three children were born to this union.

Henry was active in community affairs and in addition to his vocation of farming, was a member of the Odd Fellows; Farm Bureau, and served on the Rural Electrification Association board for a number of years in various capacities at state, county and local level. He was a state representative for 12 years from this district. He was a member of the Lacelle Methodist Church.

Clarke's three state finalists wrestled their way to 90 1/2 points and a 12th place team finish in the Iowa high school wrestling championships at Veterans Auditorium in Des Moines last week end.

Matt Diehl, Mike Laib and Joe Webb were the Clarke wrestlers that participated in the 81st annual state meet. Diehl brought home third place honors in the 105 pound class. Laib grabbed fifth at 98 pounds. Webb wrestled well but failed to place in the top six.

It was the first time ever that Clarke had qualified more than one wrestler. The three scored more team points than any Clarke team had at a state meet and also received the highest individual placing.

Commented coach Steve Moore, "All three wrestlers proved to be the more aggressive wrestler in their matches and never gave up. It goes to show that our wrestling program is on its way up."

Mike Laib found himself wrestling bigger and stronger kids in each match in the 98 pound division. But Mike rose on each occasion and proved to be the aggressor.

In the first round he scored a 16-2 superior decision over Ted Hammen of Carroll. Laib used takedown and three two-point nearfalls in the first period to run up a 8-0 lead.

After a pair of reversals in the second period Laib went back to work in the final period, scored an escape and then a takedown which resulted in a three-point nearfall and the 16-2 decision.

Round two pitted Laib against Tom Lensing of Turkey Valley. Again, he was the aggressor but Lensing was able to use counter moves to score an 8-2 victory over Laib.

In order for Mike to continue to wrestle after losing, Lensing had to win the match which he did. Lensing eventually wound up in second place in the




