Survivors include sons, Paul, Clear Lake, Robert, Sonoma, Calif., and Loyd, Lakensheth, England; daughters, Rose Marie Orr, Polk City, Laura Kilbourn, Ostrander, Minn., and Florence Stephenson and Mary Bentley, both of Webster City; several grandchildren; several great-grandchildren and several great-great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by one daughter, Wanda Cunningham; five grandchildren; her parents; two brothers and two sisters.

George M. Orr was born Oct. 4, 1896, at Manson. He attended school at Duncombe. During World War I, he served with the United States Army on the West Coast and in Alaska and was a border patrolman at the U.S.-Mexican border. In 1926, he married Gladys Reckard at Fort Dodge. The couple farmed south of Duncombe until 1956, when they moved to Brushy. He was employed by Marie Powers until his retirement. Gladys died in August 1981. He had resided at the Southfield Care Center since 1987.

He was a member of the United Methodist Church of Duncombe and was a lifetime member of the Duncombe American Legion.

Francis E. Tierney, 76, 1521 Wraywood Drive, died Saturday evening at Iowa Methodist Medical Center in Des Moines following a lengthy illness.

Services will be 10 a.m. Tuesday in the chapel of Laufersweiler-Sievers Funeral Home, and at 10:30 a.m. at Corpus Christi Catholic Church, with the Rev. Albert O. Grendler officiating at the Mass of Christian burial. Burial will be at Corpus Christi Cemetery. Visitation is after 3 p.m. today at the funeral home, where a vigil for the deceased will be held at 7 p.m. and a Knights of Columbus rosary will be at 7:30 p.m.

He was born Aug. 12, 1916 near Missouri Valley, where he attended school and graduated in 1931. He then attended the University of Iowa, graduating in 1941 with a degree in economics. Following his education he entered the United States Air Corps. and serviced as a navigator in the European Theater. After being wounded, he became a navigation instructor in Texas for the duration of the war. Following his discharge in 1945 he entered law school at the University of Iowa, graduating in 1947. He then began his law practice in Fort Dodge. In 1950 he married Iva Fisher at Corpus Christi Catholic Church and the couple established their home in Fort Dodge. In 1948 he was elected to the Iowa legislature, serving for two terms. He served as assistant county attorney, county attorney for four years, and U.S. Magistrate and Juvenile Court Referee until 1973, when he was appointed as Webster County's first associate district judge, retiring in 1983.

He was a member of the Knights of Columbus, the Elks Club, Webster County Bar Association, and various professional law associations.
