## Sherman West, 88 Dies In Texas

Sherman West, 88, a long time and well known former resident of the Moulton vicinity, died Monday, Sept. 3, 1973 at a hospital in Brownsville, Tex. He had made his home in Brownsville for the past several years.

Mr. West, who engaged in farming in this area, was a former member of the Appanoose County Board of Supervisors, and also served as an Appanoose County state senator.

He was the son of Ezekiel and Mary McFarland West. He married Hilda Newmier of Dubuque, and they lived for several years in South Dakota. They returned to Moulton following the death of his father, in order to care for his mother.

Survivors include his wife, who is in a nursing home in Brownsville; a niece, Mrs. Harold Hoyer of Centerville; two nephews, E. O. West Jr., of Centerville and Kenneth West of Verden, Okla.; and cousins, Miller West of Udell and Paul and Esta West of Unionville, Ia.


