**JOHN A. BAUMHOVER**

Mass of the Christian Burial was held at 1:30 p.m. Monday at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church in Mt. Carmel for John A. Baumhover, 83, of rural Carroll. The Rev. LeRoy Seuntjens officiated.

Mr. Baumhover died Friday, Feb. 23, at the Carroll Health Center. He had been in failing health for 10 years.

Mass servers were grandsons, Steve Kraus and John Baumhover. Gift bearers were granddaughters, Jane Baumhover and Ellen Ortner. Lector was a daughter-in-law, Mrs. Mardella Baumhover.

Pallbearers were Gerald Baumhover, Richard Baumhover, James Baumhover, Harry Baumhover, Norbert Baumhover and Kenneth Bamhover. All are nephews.

Burial was in the parish cemetery. Military services were conducted by Maurice Dunn Post No. 7 of the American Legion.

Sharp Funeral Home in Carroll was in charge of arrangements.

Mr. Baumhover was born June 7, 1895 in Carroll, the son of Henry and Mary (Walz) Baumhover. He served in France during WW I from May 27, 1918 to June 11, 1919.

His marriage to Minnie Kanne took place April 26, 1921 at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church. The couple farmed four miles north of Carroll their entire married life.

Mr. Baumhover served as state representative from Carroll County for four terms (1955-1962). He had been secretary-treasurer of the Mt. Carmel Mutual Insurance Association, president of the Carroll County Farm Bureau and had been on the board of directors of Grinnell Mutual Reinsurance Co. He also had served seven years on the ASCS and had been chairman of the service.

He was a member of the Maurice Dunn Post No. 7 of the Carroll American Legion and was the oldest living Past Grand Knight of the Charles Carroll Council Knights of Columbus. He also was a member of the 4th Degree Knights of Columbus Assembly and of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church.

Survivors include his wife, Minnie; four sons, Cletus of Denver, Colo.; Wilbur of Fonda, Erwin of Carroll and Donald of Mokena, Ill.; three daughters, Joann of Carroll, Mrs. Justin (Marilyn) Ortner of Pittsville, Wis. and Mrs. Robert (Kathy) Kraus of Carroll; 37 grandchildren; six great-grandchildren; one daughter-in-law, Mrs. Mardella Baumhover of Fonda; two brothers, Edward of Wall Lake and Albert of Carroll; two sisters, Mrs. Alois Wiedierin of Carroll and Mrs. Mary Ocken of Templeton.

He was preceded in death by four brothers and two sons, Paul Anthony and Norman.

cialists in the eastern Iowa flood plain to attend a March 1 conference in Rock Island, Ill., on flood preparedness.

"The spring flooding this year could cause enormous damage. Iowa has time to prepare for this potential emergency and it is of greatest importance to our citizens that we are prepared," the senator said.

He said the conference is being sponsored by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

The day-long conference will begin at 10 a.m. at the Sheraton Motor Inn in Rock Island.

Jepsen said the National Weather Service and the Corps will provide their 1979 flood predictions at the meeting. The conference will include addresses from representatives of government agencies and private organizations which would be involved in emergency flood relief.

A representative of the Federal Disaster Assistance Administration will address the group to advise them of procedures for getting federal disaster aid.

The FDAA granted disaster assistance to many Illinois counties while denying aid to Iowa following this winter's heavy snow storms.

Others to be represented at the meeting are the Iowa and Illinois disaster agencies, the Coast Guard, the Iowa and Illinois National Guards, the American Red Cross and the Salvation Army.

Meanwhile, Nashua officials have already started preparing for the spring thaw. The City Council was told that sacks for sandbags were in the city hall basement.

Also, Federal Insurance Administration officials met with city representatives from Hudson, LaPorte City and Dunkerton to go over flood insurance rate studies.

**Chance of rain or snow by Wednesday**

By The Associated Press Skies were generally clear throughout the state overnight with patchy areas of fog reported in the northwest.

Overnight lows ranged from 2 degrees at Waterloo to 17 at Council Bluffs after highs Sunday from 23 at Sioux City to 32 at Lamoni.

A gradually increasing southerly air flow and a moderating temperature trend is indicated over Iowa through Tuesday. A weather disturbance crossing the central Rockies will likely cause some increase in cloudiness over Iowa Tuesday and a chance of rain or snow by Wednesday.


