JIM O. HENRY

Jim O. Henry of Macedonia died at the Oakland Manor on July 1, 1997. He had attained the age of 100 years, 8 months, and 3 days.

Funeral services were held Monday, July 7, at 10:30 a.m. at the Macedonia Methodist Church, with Reverend Doug Tharpe officiating. Burial was in the Macedonia Cemetery.

Jim O. Henry was born October 28, 1896 near Macedonia, Iowa. He was one of two sons born to Tom and Sara Charlotte (Long) Henry.

Jim was united in marriage on February 20, 1918 to Cecil Lorraine Pilling at her parents' home in Macedonia. Their marriage was blessed with the birth of two children, James and Marilyn.

Jim was a member of the East Pottawattamie County A.A.A. Committee from 1934 to 1938. He served on the Pottawattamie County Board of Supervisors from 1939 to 1953, and eleven years as chairman.

Jim served as president of the Iowa County Officers Association from 1943 to 1945, and served in the 55th and 56th General Assembly in the House of Representatives.

Jim served two terms in the Iowa State Senate and was also a member of the State Board of Control.

Jim and Lorraine moved to the Oakland Manor in November of 1996. In 1997, they celebrated their 79th wedding anniversary.

Jim is preceded in death by his parents and brother John M. Henry.

He is survived by his wife Lorraine; son James W. Henry and his wife Annie of Carson, Iowa; daughter Marilyn and her husband Merrill Houser of Carson; six grandsons; 18 great-grandchildren and 3 great-great-grandchildren.
