Miller, 68, veteran Knoxville attorney, who died early Sunday morning at West Ridge Nursing Home following an extended illness. The services will be conducted by Dr. Leonard Deaver, with burial in Lincoln Cemetery.

A native of Marion County, Miller was a graduate of Iowa Wesleyan College and the Drake University College of Law. He was a former chairman of the State Tax Commission, represented Marion County in the State Senate, and also served the community as County Attorney.

He was a member of local fraternal organizations, including the I.O.O.F., Masonic Lodge, and Shrine.

Survivors include his wife, Esther; two daughters, Mrs. Elizabeth Youngberg, West Des Moines, and Mrs. Eleanor Ogden, of Northfield, Minn.; five grandchildren; a sister, Mrs. Edna Hem, of Knoxville, and a brother, Robert, of Exira.


