Services today for Hillman Sersland, 79

Funeral services are today at Washington Prairie Lutheran Church for Hillman Sersland, 79, of Decorah.

Mr. Sersland, a former Winneshiek County state representative, died Monday at his son Howard's residence in rural Decorah. He had served in the Iowa General Assembly as a member of the House from 1952 to 1962. He also farmed and operated the Sersland Implement Company here.

The Rev. Richard Sansgaard and the Rev. Percy Larson will conduct the services. Organist is Paul Bruvold and soloist is Norman Gjevre. Sensor-French Funeral Home is in charge of the arrangements and burial is at the Washington Prairie Cemetery. Pallbearers are Keith Sersland, Ronald Sersland, Rodney Sersland, David Bostrom, Mark Bostrom, and Dennis Cline.

Hillman Howard Jonas Sersland was born Aug. 10, 1906, the eldest of nine children, in Winneshiek County, a son of Halvor and Malla (Brown) Sersland of Decorah. He attended rural schools of

Winneshiek County and graduated from Luther College with the class of 1926, in the preparatory department. He married the former Irene W. Olson of Decorah on Aug. 28, 1929.

He was an active member of the Washington Prairie Lutheran Church, where he held numerous offices. He was also a member and past president of the Winneshiek County Farm Bureau, a charter member and past president of the local Lion's Club, a member of the Winneshiek County Health Improvement board and Elks Club.

Survivors include two sons, Howard and his wife Carol of Decorah and Walter and his wife Sonja of Monona; one daughter Marilyn Bostrom and her husband Gary of West Union; nine grandchildren; five great-grandchildren; three brothers, Raymond of Decorah, Arnold of Mt. Vernon, Wash., and Kenneth Sersland of Madison, Wis.; and three sisters, Agnes (Mrs. Orval) Seegmiller of Waterloo, Elsie (Mrs. John) Cutting of Decorah and Florence Johnson of Decorah.
