Sewer camera for rent

CORNING — Communities within a 30-mile radius of Corning may now rent the city's sewer camera for fees established at Monday's City Council meeting.

Rates were previously determined for local use: \$50 flat fee on weekdays and \$50 plus time and half wages on weekends.

A request from a Villisca resident to use the camera prompted discussion on out-of-town rates.

The council agreed to charge a \$75 flat fee plus \$25 per hour for users within a 30-miles radius of Corning.

Although the sewer camera is available to residents and cities, Mayor Marvin Steffen said "We're
