

# Henry C. Nelson rites Monday at Forest City

Henry C. Nelson, former Winnebago County auditor and member of the Iowa Legislature, died Friday, February 22, 1980, at the Forest City Hospital. He was 79 years of age.

Funeral services were held Monday at Immanuel Lutheran Church, Forest City, with the Rev. Charles W. Hanko, pastor of First Congregational Church, of which Nelson was a member, officiating. Burial was in Oakland Cemetery.

Henry C. Nelson was born in Hershey. Wisconsin, December 7, 1900, the son of Lars and Theoline Nelson. He moved with his parents when he was a small child to Hartford, South Dakota. He graduated from high school in Hartford and attended college in Spearfish, South Dakota.

He worked for a telephone company in Hartford for several years before moving to Forest City in 1934 where he was employed by a utility company. During World War II he served in the United States Navy. He returned to Forest City where he worked in farm and general property management.

In 1954 he was elected to the lowa House of Representatives, serving five two-year terms. January 9, 1961, he was elected Speaker of the House. In 1964 he retired from the Legislature and

ran for the office of Winnebago County auditor, a post he held until his retirement in 1976.

Mr. Nelson served as general chairman of the Waldorf College 50th Anniversary Fund in 1953, was the first president of the Forest City Development, Inc. in 1956.
