**Carroll L. Price**, 76 of Knoxville, passed away Tuesday of cancer at the Knoxville Area Community Hospital. Services were held on Thursday at Bybee and Davis Funeral Home with interment at Graceland Cemetery.

Price was well known in the Knoxville community. He was elected to the Iowa Senate in 1957 and served two terms. He also was appointed to the State Board of Control from which he retired in 1978.

Price owned and operated Hawkeye Mill and Hawkeye Farm

Equipment. He was a member of the First United Methodist Church, Oriental Lodge No. 61 AF and AM and the Za-Ga-Zig Shrine Temple in Des Moines.

He was a 1930 graduate from Knoxville High School. He married Mildred Betterton on Aug. 30, 1930.

He is survived by his wife Mildred; a daughter, Janet Nash of Fairfield; a sister, Irene Myers of Casa Grande, Ariz.; six grandchildren and three great-grandchildren. A memorial has been established to the American Cancer Society.

Services for Carroll L. Price, 76, of Knoxville, who died Feb. 17, 1987 at Knoxville Area Community Hospital, were held Feb. 19 at Bybee and Davis Funeral Home.

Interment was in Graceland Cemetery.

Mr. Price was born Dec. 6, 1910 in Marion County, the son of Matthew and Gertie Coe Price.

Operating Hawkeye Mill in Knoxville for a number of years, in 1940 he became owner of Hawkeye

Farm Equipment Company.

In 1957, he was elected to his first term in the Iowa Senate. During his second term he was appointed to Social Service and later to the Board of Control, a capacity he served in until 1978.

He was a former member of the Knoxville Community School Board, had served on the Marion County Fair Board, and was a member of the First United Methodist Church, Oriental Lodge No. 61 A.F. & A.M., and the Za-Ga-Zig Shrine Club of Des Moines.

He was preceded in death by his parents; one daughter, JoAnn in 1979; and three sisters, Pearl, Lillian, and Olive.

He is survived by his wife; one daughter, Mrs. Larry (Janet) Nash of Fairfield; six grandchildren; three great grandchildren; and one sister, Irene Myers of Casa Grande, Ariz.


