**COUNCIL BLUFFS, Iowa (AP)** — Iowa's history-for-kids magazine, the Goldfinch, will increase its circulation 40 fold next year when all of the state's fifth graders get complimentary subscriptions.

The gift comes from the Iowa Sesquicentennial Commission, which donated \$100,000 of the money raised through the sale of special license plates.

The Goldfinch, a publication of the State Historical Society, has built a subscription of about 1,000 since it began in 1978. There will be about 40,000 fifth graders next year.


# Services slated for former Rep. Richard L. Stephens
