CARL H. HENSLEY
Carl H. Hensley, the son
of William and Minnie Dett-
man Hensley, was born
February 15, 1897 in Audu-
bon County, Iowa and died
February 15, 1985 at the
Exira Care Center in Exira
at the age of 88 years.

He received his education
in the Audubon County
Schools and first attended
the Greeley Center Metho-
dist Church. He served in
the U.S. Army during World
War I.

On March 3, 1919 he
married Edith Hansen and
they farmed in Greeley
Township. She died Novem-
ber 15, 1943. He remained
on the farm with his daugh-
ter and son-in-law, Bernice
and Ronald St. John for 25
years until his marriage to
Evelyn Hamlin Miller on
December 23, 1969. They
lived in Braddyville, Iowa
until 1972 when they moved
to Exira. After one month in
the hospital he became a
resident of the Exira Care
Center two weeks before his
death. He was a member of
the Exira Christian Church.

He served in the Iowa
Legislature in the 1957-58
and 1961-62 sessions, was
very active in soil conserva-
tion and was an early AAA
committeeman, was presi-
dent of the REA Board for a
number of years, and was

active in the Braddyville
Lions Club.

Preceding him in death in
addition to his wife, Edith,
were his parents; a twin
sister, Winnie Bauder; sis-
ters, Hazel Anciaux and
Martha Bickett; and half-
brothers and sisters, Clyde
and Ed Hensley, Mrs. Gus
(Ina) Wahlert, Mrs. George
(Mayme) Wahlert and Mrs.
Vernon (Verna) Deets.

Survivors include his wife,
Evelyn Hensley of Exira; his
children and their spouses,
LeRoy W. and Phyllis
Hensley of Modesto, Cal.,
and Bernice and Ben Olsen
of Hayward, Cal.; his grand-
children, Sherill Niehouse of
Kansas City, Mo., Beth
Owens of Dillon, Colo., Scott
Hensley of Lodi, Cal., Chris-
tine Krejsa of Pacific Grove,
Cal., Britt Hensley of Vaca-
ville, Cal., and Brian
Hensley of Hayward, Cal.; 5
great-grandchildren and
several nieces, nephews and
other relatives.

conducted by Rev. R. Carrol
Johnson on Monday, Febru-
