SAMUEL ERNEST ROBINSON

Samuel (Sam) Robinson, eldest son of James Ira Robinson and Martha Lucy (Johnson) Robinson, was born October 7, 1894 near Preemption, Ill. In the spring of 1902, he moved with his family to Dodge Township at Yale, Iowa. He graduated from Guthrie County High School at Panora in 1914. He also took extension short courses between semesters while attending high

school and received several awards in agriculture judging. He served with the U.S. Army 88th Division during World War I in France.

He was married to Bessie L. Miller December 11, 1920 at the Methodist Parsonage in Guthrie Center. They lived in rural Redfield, later moving to farms near Stuart, Casey and Guthrie Center. To this union were born seven children, four daughters and three sons.

In 1946, they retired from active

farming and moved to Guthrie Center where Sam remained very active raising purebred Duroc hogs and also conducted an insurance business and served as Justice of the Peace. Sam represented Guthrie County as a State Representative for four terms from 1957 to 1964. He was active in any organization that he was involved. He was a loyal and devout member of the Methodist Church and actively involved throughout the years in the lay mission of the church and he served as a trustee for many years. He was a member of the 32nd Degree Masons, American Legion, I.O.O.F., O.E.S., Rebekahs, Lions Club, Farm Bureau, Izaak Walton, Guthrie County Historical Society, former chairman of the County Conservation Board, chairman of the County Judicial Magistrate Commission, Mahon Ray Boys Camp for 25 years.

On Dec. 11, 1980 Mr. and Mrs. Robinson celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary.

He passed away at the Guthrie County Hospital July 15, 1985 at the age of 90 years.

He was preceded in death by his wife in 1984, his parents, one brother, one sister, and one grandson. Surviving are his seven children, Donald of Laurens, Robert of Exira, Mrs. Vern (Marjorie) Slaybaugh of Panora, Paul of Grand Rapids, Mich., Mrs. Gerry (Mary) Joyce of Grand Froks, N.D., Mrs. Bruce (Betty) Parks of Milford, and Mrs. Gale (Patricia) Graves of Carrollton, Ga.; 20 grandchildren and 15 great-grandchildren.

Funeral services were Thursday, July 18 from the Guthrie Center Methodist Church with Rev. Peter Siemens officiating. Interment was in Union Cemetery.




