Worthington dies; former state auditor

Former Iowa State Auditor Lorne Worthington, 61, of New York City died of cancer Saturday. Memorial services will be at 1:30 p.m. Sunday at the Williams Club in New York City.
Mr. Worthington's career in Iowa government began in 1962, when he was elected to a two-year term in the House of Representatives. At age 24, he was one of the youngest members ever elected. In 1964, Mr. Worthington was elected state auditor in a Democratic landslide that swept Republicans out of the Statehouse. He failed to win re-election in 1966. Gov. Harold Hughes then appointed him Iowa commissioner of insurance, a post he held for about five years. He then joined Preferred Risk Mutual Insurance Co. in West Des Moines, and was the firm's president and chief executive officer from 1979 to 1982. Mr. Worthington then moved to the eastern United States, serving as executive vice president of New Hampshire Insurance Co., managing director of Seabury & Smith, and chairman and chief executive officer of Vector Marketing and Research. He had also served on the board of trustees for Graceland College in Lamoni.
He is survived by four daughters, Penelope Thomas of Lincoln, Neb.; Deborah Worthington of Middletown, N.J.; and Suzanne Menard and Nisa Ulep, both of Washington, D.C.; three sons, Michael of Ashland, Va.; Jonathan of Des Moines and Chad of Washington, D.C.; and 12 grandchildren.
