James L. Quinn, 71, dies Monday

James Louis Quinn, retired area farmer and former state legislator, died Monday, April 22, 1965, at Washington County Hospital following an apparent heart attack. Mr. Quinn, 71, had suffered a previous attack last month while vacationing in Dallas, Texas.


The funeral will be at 10:30 a.m. Thursday at St. James Catholic Church with the Rev. John Whalen officiating. Interment will be at Elm Grove Cemetery. A rosary will be recited Wednesday at 7:30 p.m. at the Eden Funeral Home. Visitation begins Wednesday morning. Memorials may be given to the American Heart Association or a charity of the giver's choice.

James Quinn was born May 28, 1913, in Louisa County to Robert and May Smith Quinn. He was reared in Ainsworth and Washington rural areas and attended Ainsworth schools. He graduated from the University of Iowa with a degree in business and accounting.

On June 16, 1934, he married Gretchen Heise at Marion.

Mr. Quinn was active in community affairs for many years. He was a former member of the Ainsworth School Board and the Ainsworth State Bank Board. From 1965 to 1966, he represented Washington County as an Iowa legislator. During World War II, he served on the selective service board of Washington County.

A lover of music, Mr. Quinn was a longtime member of the Washington community band, Kaaba Shrine band in Davenport and Jimmy Dennis Dance Band. He was an active member of the Masonic Lodge and

Kaaba Shrine. He was also a member of St. James Catholic Church.

A farmer for many of his working years, Mr. Quinn had most recently owned and operated a small farm equipment business at his home at Route 2, Washington. He had worked for two years following college graduation for John Hancock Life Insurance at Cedar Rapids.

Survivors include: his wife; eight children, Judith Crawford of Arlington, Va., James Jr., of Duncanville, Texas, Robert of Rockwall, Texas, John of Antigonish, Nova Scotia, Canada, Sarah Shanahan of Springfield, Ore., Joseph of Dallas, Michael of rural Ainsworth and Matthew of Dallas; six grandchildren and two step-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents.
