Paul B. McCray, 76, former Scott County Board supervisor and former Davenport alderman, died Monday at Americana Healthcare Center, Davenport.

Services for McCray, who resided at 808 Slavens Manor, Bettendorf, will be 10:30 a.m. Thursday at Trinity Episcopal Cathedral, Davenport. Burial will be in Davenport Memorial Park.

Visitation is 3 to 6 p.m. Wednesday at Runge Mortuary.

Memorials may be made to the cathedral, of which he was a member, or Shriner Crippled Children's Hospital.

He had been a general agent for Mutual Benefit Life Insurance, Newark, N.J., and was president of Silver Creek Mobile Home Park, Davenport.

Mr. McCray married Margaret Burnett in 1943 in Norfolk, Va.

Mr. McCray served in the Iowa House of Representatives from 1966 to 1968. During that period, he was regarded by some

as the "watchdog of the treasury" for his tight-fisted fiscal policies.

He served as a Scott County supervisor for four years from 1968 to 1972. During his term on the board, he was instrumental in establishing a full-time welfare investigator.

Mr. McCray served one term as Davenport's 6th Ward alderman.

He was a Navy veteran during World War II, serving as a lieutenant and communications officer.

He was a member of Trinity Masonic Lodge 208 AF & AM and Moose Lodge, both of Davenport; Davenport Consistory; member and past potentate of Kaaba Temple Shrine, Davenport; and past director of Royal Court of Jesters.

Survivors include his wife; a daughter, Anne Hoepfer, Clinton, Iowa; sons, Larry, Cedar Rapids, Iowa; Paul Jr., Iowa City; and David, Hickory, N.C.; six grandchildren; and a brother, Ben, Atlanta.
