 Carroll I. Redfern, 88,
 Mount Pleasant, died
 Tuesday, Sept. 7, 1993,
 at the home of his
 daughter.
 Born March 25, 1905,
 near New London, he
 was the son of Ray and
 Hannah Broeker Red-
 fern. On July 3, 1928, he
 married Evea Fern Was-
 son. She died Feb. 26,
 1984.
 Mr. Redfern was a
 graduate of Iowa State
 College at Ames, and a
 50-year resident of Don-
 nellson. He served as
 Lee County 4-H Club
 Agent in 1930, and as
 County Agricultural
 Agent from 1933 to 1940.
 He then opened his real
 estate office, later ad-
 ding tax and accounting
 services; was a hybrid
 seed corn district
 manager, and was the
 land maintenance super-
 visor for the Iowa Or-

dinance Plant when it
 started.
 Redfern served on the
 Lee County Board of
 Review for 22 years, was
 Lee County Representa-
 tive in the Iowa Legisla-
 ture for the 1965 and
 1967 sessions, and
 served nearly 10 years
 as Mayor of Donnellson.
 He had been a long-time
 member of the Lee Coun-
 ty Fair Board, Farm
 Bureau, Lions, and the
 Donnellson Methodist
 Church. After moving to
 Mount Pleasant in 1979,
 he was a member of the
 First United Methodist
 Church, Mount Pleasant
 Lions and the Senior
 Citizens Center.

Survivors include one
 daughter, Mrs. Richard
 L. (Nancy) Thuma,
 Mount Pleasant; one
 son, Merlin, Gainesville,
 Fla.; six grandchildren,
 15 great-grandchildren
 and one sister, Frances
 Hundt, Tremont, Ill.

 was preceded in death by
 his parents, one brother,
 Kenneth, and two
 sisters, Lola Hundt and
 Bessie Kurtz.
