Hazel C.F. Bramman, 86



Twp. In 1903 they purchased the 80 acre farmstead a mile east and 2½ south of Irwin where Neil still lives.

Eleven children were born to this marriage: Neil Merlene, 1892, died as a small child; Charlotte, Mrs. Lars Ostebee, born 1894; Nellie Isabel, 1896, died as a small child; Neil Ishmael, 1898; Isabel, Mrs. Hjalmer Wiig, 1900; Mollie, Mrs. Jake Knudsen, 1902; Ina, Mrs. Hoyt Duke, 1904; Luther, 1908; Lula, Mrs. Lewis Hodnefield, 1911; Thomas, 1913; and Russell, 1915.

The Nelson children attended Highland Grove School until the Irwin school district was enlarged, then those still attending school went to the Danway School.

All the children received their confirmation instruction in the Lutheran Church in the Norwegian language giving them a "second language."

Inger suffered a stroke at the age of 51 and was an invalid for eight years until her death in 1932. Tom continued to live out his life on the farm until 1958 when at age 93 he died at home.

Alfred Nielsen

Alfred Nielsen was born Dec. 9, 1901 at Defiance, Iowa, son of Jesse and Bertha Nielsen who were immigrants to America from Denmark. Alfred was educated in the Shelby County schools.

On Feb. 29, 1929 he married Leta Arlene Morrison, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. W. G. Morrison of Dow City. Leta received her early education in the country schools of Shelby and Crawford County and graduated from Defiance Public High School. She received a Normal Training Certificate and taught school in the Shelby County country school system.

During their first four years of married life, Alfred and Leta lived on a farm northeast of Defiance. Then they moved to a farm south of Defiance where they lived until 1974 when Leta passed away. Their children are Ruth Ann (Mrs. Milton Barry) of Irwin; Marlin of Las Vegas, Nev.; and Marie (Mrs. Lee McLaughlin) of Defiance. There are six grandchildren. Leta and Alfred owned and operated 640 acres of land in Shelby and Crawford County.

Leta and Alfred have been members of the Defiance Salem United Methodist Church where Alfred served as trustee and financial treasurer. Leta was active in women's church work, was Sunday school leader, youth sponsor, and music director. She also was active in 4-H work, Shelby County Cancer Assn., and Order of the Eastern Star. For five years Alfred was president of the Irwin Community School Board at which time the new school was built. He was voting delegate of Farm Bureau for five years, helped organize and

was president of the Shelby County Good Roads Assn., and belongs to Masonic Lodge, Shrine, and Order of the Eastern Star. Alfred served five terms in the Iowa House of Representatives, being active on many state committees. During this time, Leta served as his secretary and was a member of the League of Legislative Ladies. Their life together was an active one in church, community, and family affairs.

On April 28, 1975 Alfred married Helen Tryon Hulsebus of Carroll, Iowa. They now live in Harlan.



Axel Nielsen

Axel Nielsen was born to Anders C. and Inger Marie Nielsen on Apr. 7, 1904 in Bronderslev, Denmark, where his parents owned and operated a bakery.

Axel came with his parents to America on Mar. 1, 1909 and settled on a farm which they purchased in Polk Twp.

He grew to manhood on this farm receiving his education at Polk No. 1 and Irwin High. He worked with his father on the farm until his father died in Feb. 1939. He continued to farm there until retiring to Irwin in 1961.

Axel was married to Vera Opal Kragelund on July 10, 1935. Her birthdate is Mar. 19, 1913. She was a graduate of Exira High and taught Polk No. 1 School in Shelby Co. for three years and Oakfield Twp. No. 6 in Audubon Co. for one year before her marriage. Vera was the daughter of Peter and Nellie Kragelund. She has one sister, Viola, Mrs. Clarence Nelson of Kimballton and one brother, Leo, of Elk Horn.

Axel's mother passed away in 1962.

Axel has been a member of Merrill's Grove Baptist Church in Polk Twp. since age 13. He has held various positions in the church. He sang in the choir for many years and was a member of the Merrill's Grove Church Orchestra, playing the violin.

Vera was a member of Elk Horn First Baptist Church from the age of 11 until her marriage when she transferred her membership to Merrill's Grove. She has held various offices in the Women's Missionary Society and taught a junior


