**WATERLOO** — Charles John Uban II, 82, of  
Waterloo, died Tuesday, Sept. 2, at Sartori  
Memorial Hospital, Cedar Falls.

He was born June 29, 1921, in Thompson, son of  
John and Mildred Jensen Uban. He married  
Emma Jo Schnucker on Aug. 2, 1945, in Waterloo.

Mr. Uban was a graduate of West Waterloo High  
School and Iowa State University with a mechani-  
cal engineering degree. He was a pilot in the  
China National Aviation Corps AVG (Flying  
Tigers) during World War II. He was stationed in  
the India-Burma Theater of Operations and was  
decorated by the U.S. Air Force with the Distinguished Flying  
Cross, Air Medal and four Bronze Service Stars, and well as deco-  
rations from the Chinese government.

He was a pilot for Pan American Airlines and served two terms  
as a state representative. He owned and operated Uban Oil Co.,  
Waterloo, for over 50 years, receiving a citation from Governor  
Branstad for "Excellence in Energy Conservation."
