Emil J. Husak

A funeral liturgy for Emil Joseph Husak, 66, a well known Toledo area farmer and past State Representative and Senator of rural Toledo, was held Saturday, Aug. 2, 1997 from St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Tama. Fr. Keith L. Birch was the celebrant.

A vigil service was held at 7 p.m. Friday evening, Aug. 1 from Hand's Funeral Home, Tama.

Burial was in St. Patrick's Cemetery, Tama, with military honors by the Toledo American Legion.

Born Sept. 18, 1930 at Toledo, he was the son of William and Mary Zmolek Husak. He received his education in the rural schools near the area of his birth and grew to manhood on a farm near Toledo.

July 23, 1952, he was inducted into the U.S. Army at Des Moines. He served with HQ. Battery, 9AAA Gun Bn.

June 21, 1954, he received an honorable discharge at Presidio of San Francisco, CA. and returned to the Toledo area.

Aug. 16, 1955 he was united in marriage to Dorothy M. Uhlenberg of Garwin at St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Tama. The couple have always farmed east of Toledo.

Mr. Husak also served as State Representative from 1970-1980 when he was elected State Senator. He served in this capacity until 1996.

He was a member of St. Patrick's Catholic Church, Tama-Toledo; Toledo American Legion Post #72; Kiwanis, K.D. Lodge, Fraternal Order of Eagles, Aerie 2828 and the 40
