

BOSWELL, Leonard L., 1934-

BOSWELL, Leonard L., a Representative from Iowa; born in Harrison County, Mo., January 10, 1934; graduated Lamoni High School, Lamoni, Iowa, 1952; B.A., Graceland College, Lamoni, Iowa, 1969; served in the United States Army, 1956-1976; farmed and served on the board of directors of the local farmer's cooperative, 1979-1993, and was president for thirteen years; member of the Iowa state senate, 1984-1996; president of the Iowa state senate, 1992-1996; elected as a Democrat to the One Hundred Fifth and to the two succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1997-January 3, 2003).
