

Senator Tinsman was first elected to the Iowa Senate in 1988. Currently, she serves as Co-chair of the Health and Human Services Appropriations Sub-committee. She is a member of the Human Resources, Judiciary, State Government, and Appropriations committees.

Senator Tinsman serves on the Iowa Empowerment Board, the Medical Assistance Advisory Committee and the Iowa Prevention of Disabilities Council. She is active with the National Conference of State Legislators (Vice-chair of AFI Health committee and Executive Committee Member of the Forum for State Health Policy), Women in Government (State Director) and National Foundation for Women Legislators. Prior to her election to the Iowa Senate, Senator Tinsman served as a Scott County Supervisor from 1978-1988.

Senator Tinsman is active in St. Peter's Episcopal Church, Bettendorf, serving in several local, state diocesan and national leadership positions. She is a Director of the American Lung Association of Illinois/Iowa, Iowa Peace Institute, and The FINE (First in the Nation in Education) Foundation. She is active in both the Bettendorf and Davenport Chambers of Commerce and Davenport Rotary Club.

She graduated from the University of Colorado in 1958 with a B.A. in Sociology. She is a member of Phi Beta Kappa, Pi Gamma Mu, and Mortar Board (honorary). In 1974, she earned her M.S.W. at the University of Iowa.

Senator Tinsman received the Guardian of Small Business Award in 1996 and The Iowa Coalition of Family and Children Service Public Service Award in 1997.

She is a lifelong resident of the Quad Cities and has been married for 43 years to Hovey Tinsman. They have 3 children and 5 grandchildren.
