--Hon. Michael Price, member of the 8th and 9th General Assemblies from Muscatine county, died in that city on the 9th inst., at the age of sixty years. He has been for over twenty years a resident of the county.

—The *Glenwood Opinion* chronicles the suicide of Mrs. Charles West by hanging, and the death of Dr. White by poison, whether designedly or accidentally administered is unknown. Both were citizens of Mills county.

—The *Gazette* states that a full company of Fenians have been organized in Davenport who are ready to march any day for the seat of war.—The same paper farther states that another company is nearly full.

—At a "Charivari" near Terento, Clinton county, a few days ago, one of the noisy musicians, after due warning to the crowd from the justly incensed bridegroom, received in his body the contents of a shot gun, or one hundred and seventy-two small bird shot, as the physician asserts, yet was not dangerously wounded!—*De Witt Observer*.

—The *Corydon Monitor* publishes the particulars of a most diabolical murder committed near Lineville, Wayne county, on the 22d ult., by a German named Wm. Hoogman, who killed his neighbor named George Kilder, for his money, and after chopping his body to pieces with an axe burned it in the fire place. Kilder lived alone, and was murdered in his own house. Spots of blood were found on the floor and pieces of the skull and body were dug out of the ashes. Most of the bones had been pounded to pieces. Portions of the murdered man's saddle were found in the ashes, burned, probably, to substantiate the murderer's story that he had gone away on horseback. It is supposed that the murderer was engaged in his devilish work of burning the remains during the entire night of February 22d. Hoogman is now in jail at Princeton, Mo., awaiting trial.

—Florian Yeager has been arrested and held for trial at Dubuque on a charge of stealing priestly garments, &c., from the Catholic Churches in that city. The *Times* says: "The garments stolen were three surplices, one alb, and some minor articles, in all worth between forty and fifty dollars.

James O'Toole grew to manhood on the home farm and after receiving his preliminary education in the district school carried his studies further in the schools of Iowa City. He taught school for some time but, being naturally inclined toward agricultural pursuits, for which he was well fitted by early training under his father, he rented the old homestead, which he now owns and which is to him of special value on account of its associations. His farm comprises three hundred and sixty acres on section 20, Seventy-six township. Here he carries on general agriculture, also specializing in the raising and feeding of cattle and hogs, in which he has attained a high degree of success.

In 1884 Mr. O'Toole was united in marriage to Miss Margaret Ryan, who was born in Muscatine county in 1861 and is a daughter of Dennis and Kathrine (Dalton) Ryan. The parents were born in Ireland and came to America in the early '50s. They spent their latter days at Davenport, Iowa. Eight children have come to brighten the home of Mr. and Mrs. O'Toole, namely: William P., who is a graduate of the State University of Iowa; Philip J., at home; Winifred A., also at home; Mary J.; Edward D. and James F., twins; and Emmett J. and Louis Gerald, also twins.

Mr. O'Toole affiliates with the democratic party and is a staunch upholder of its principles. He has served as clerk of the township for four years and also as member of the school board. He and his family are sincere believers in Christianity and hold membership in the Catholic church. By many kindly acts he has won the regard of those with whom he has associated and no man in the township is more highly respected by citizens generally than the one whose name introduces this sketch. Generous in sentiment and true in the discharge of every obligation, he has brought up his children under the same favoring influences and they are now a credit not only to their parents but to their state and country.

WILLIAM H. NEIL.

William H. Neil, a respected citizen of Seventy-six township, where he has made his home for more than forty years, was born in the state of Maine, October 22, 1826, and is a son of William and Isabel (Dugan) Neil, the mother also a native of Maine and the father of New Hampshire. William Neil, Sr., removed with his family to Iowa in 1842 and for twenty-two years lived upon a farm in Des Moines county. In 1864 he came to Muscatine county, where he purchased land and continued until his death, which occurred four years later. The mother was called away in 1900, at the venerable age of ninety-nine years, six months and three days. She was the mother of six children, only one of whom, the subject of this review, is now living.

William H. Neil was educated in the district schools and remained at home until he was twenty-one years of age, when he commenced farming for himself upon rented land. In 1868, having prospered financially, he removed to the farm where he now lives. It comprises forty acres on section 29, Seventy-six township, and he has made many substantial improvements thereon.

In 1865 Mr. Neil was united in marriage to Miss Ellen Price, who was born in Pike county, Ohio, in 1844, a daughter of Michael and Rachel (Foster) Price. Her father was a native of Virginia and her mother of Ohio. They came to Muscatine county in 1848, and continued here during the remainder of their lives. Mr. Price was representative of Muscatine County for one term in the legislature at Des Moines about 1860. There were ten children in their family, only one of whom is now living. To Mr. and Mrs. Neil two children were born: Carrie N. received a good education and became one of the popular school teachers of the township. She makes her home with her father. Laura E., who was born July 11, 1868, grew to beautiful womanhood but was called away August 27, 1897, at the age of twenty-nine years.

Mr. Neil gives his allegiance to the republican party and although he has not sought political office he has served to the general satisfaction of tax payers of the township as trustee and assessor. He is a stanch friend of education and has filled the office of secretary of the school board. Fraternally he is identified with Lodge No. 671, I. O. O. F., of Letts, Iowa, and has passed through all the chairs of the lodge. One of the greatest sorrows of his life was the loss of his beloved wife, who passed away January 19, 1908, and her remains were deposited by loving hands in Letts cemetery. Mr. Neil and his daughter are members of the Methodist Episcopal church and are sustained by a faith in a reunion with those who have gone before which is founded on divine promise. The life of Mr. Neil has been an open book, and as he rests from his labors he has the satisfaction of knowing that he has assisted to the extent of his ability in advancing the happiness of those with whom he has been associated.

H. C. PLETT.

H. C. Plett, who devotes his time and energies to the pursuits of farming and stock-raising, is the owner of seventy-five acres of rich and productive land in Fulton township. His birth occurred in Scott county, Iowa, on the 24th of August, 1856, his parents being Hans and Sophia (Arp) Plett, both of whom were natives of Germany. The father was twice married, his first wife passing away while en route to the United States. By her he had one son, Henry, who is now engaged in business at Blue Grass, Scott county, Iowa. For his second wife Hans Plett chose Miss Sophia Arp, whom he wedded in Iowa. Subsequently he took up general agricultural pursuits, being actively engaged in the cultivation of rented land until called to his final rest in 1898. His second wife passed away in 1890. The children born of that union were as follows: H. C., of this review; Louis, who is a resident of Blue Grass, Iowa; Elizabeth, of Muscatine county; William, living in Scott county; Charles, a resident of Muscatine; John, who makes his home in Scott county; August, who acts as general manager of an implement business at Blue Grass, Iowa; George and Frank, of Muscatine, Iowa.

H. C. Plett remained under the parental roof until he had attained the age of twenty-seven years, when he started out as an agriculturist on his own account, cultivating rented land for seven years. On the expiration of that period he em-

DEATH OF AN OLD CITIZEN. --Hon. Michael Price, a prominent citizen of this county, died at his residence Seventy-Six township on Friday night last. Mr. P. was about sixty years of age, and had been a resident county over twenty years. He was elected to the Legislature twice from this county, and served with great acceptability to his constituents. He was also on the Board of Supervisors several terms, and made an industrious and useful member. Our county has lost one of its best citizens in the death of Mr. P., whose honest integrity and active zeal in every good work had won for him many warm friends.

MUSCATINE JOURNAL FRIDAY, MARCH 16, 1866 OBITUARY

Died at his residence on Seventy-Six township, Muscatine Co., on the 9th inst., after an illness of sixteen of lung fever, MICHAEL PRICE, aged 55 years 4 months and 25 days.

The deceased was a native of Virginia, and inherited the hospitable and large-hearted views of its early better class of inhabitants. He emigrated to Ohio in 1828, and came to Iowa in 1847, making his home county, where he has resided ever since, part of the time in this city. As a public man--having been twice elected to the Legislature, and having been for several terms a member of the Board of Supervisors--he distinguished for his plain and practical good sense, his zeal for the public welfare, and his unswerving integrity. As a neighbor, he was Highly respected and universally esteemed. As a husband, father and friend his loss will be more keenly felt and more deeply lamented. We extend to the bereaved friends and relatives our warmest sympathies in their sad and unexpected loss.



HOUTZ CEMETERY SEVENTY-SIX TOWNSHIP MUSCATINE COUNTY, IOWA

Also known as
**High Prairie Cemetery, 1st Methodist Episcopal Church
Vannatti / Vanatta Cemetery**

Directions to the cemetery: From Muscatine, turning off Route 61 on 231st Street, formerly known as Lord's Ferry Road or G-28, and go west for six miles. The cemetery will be on the right hand side of the road. It is fenced but there is no sign.

This cemetery database was compiled for you, by Larry Beik, who walked thru this cemetery on September 22, 2001. Dave Dunston converted this database over to html so it could be put online. January 25, 2008 Eleanor McCleary added the following cemetery history and information from WPA records.

Back in 1854 the First Methodist Episcopal Church had a circuit rider minister who served the congregation who lived in Lake, Seventy-Six and Cedar Townships in Muscatine County. Services were held in homes and little schoolhouses.

The land, for which to build a church in Lake Township, was acquired by the Trustees of Methodist Episcopal Church at High Prairie in 1863. There were two acres from Thomas M. Isett, recorded in the **Muscatine County Record of Lands - Book Z**, pages 601 & 602. It is titled: **Isett to M.E. Church Deed**. Then another acre was acquired from Mary and Lindley Hoopes(es) in 1864. This deed was titled **Hoopes to M.E. Church** and was recorded in **Muscatine County Record of Lands - Book Z**, pages 600 & 601.

There were two cemeteries established by this congregation. One was located next to the chapel building. Its plat map was filed for record in December, 1864. It may be found at the Muscatine County Recorder's office in the **Book of Lands, Book Z** on pages 580 & 581. It is titled: "**Cemetery grounds 1st Methodist Episcopal Church High Prairie**", located on Main road South in Lake Township. Another parcel of land was purchased by the church trustees for the purpose of a cemetery from Leonard and Sarah Houtz. It was located on Lord's Ferry road in Seventy-Six Township. This transaction may be found in the **Muscatine County Record of Lands, Book Y** on pages 438 and 439, titled as: **Houtz to M.E. Church Deed.**

Know all men by these present that Leonard Houtz and Sarah Houtz, his wife of the county of Muscatine State of Iowa in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars in hand paid by the incorporate Trustees of church property of the M.E. Church of Muscatine circuit Iowa Conference according to discipline of Muscatine County State of Iowa the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledge do by their presents assign Bargain Sell and convey unto the said Trustees aforesaid and their successors forever the following described premises situated in the county of Muscatine and State of Iowa.

To Wit: One Acre in the south East corner of the west half of the North East of Section No. four Tp Seventy Six North Range No. Three West of the 5th P.M. State of Iowa and bounded as follows beginning at South East corner of said Lot Thence North three chains fifty links Thence West Two chains and Eighty Six links Thence South Three chains & fifty links Thence East ten chains and Eighty Six links for beginning.

To Have and to Hold the said premises unto the said Trustees and their Successors forever And the said Leonard Houtz and Sarah Houtz do hereby covenant with the said Trustees and their successors that they lawfully seized of said premises that they are free from incumbrance that they have good right and lawful authority to sell the same And they do freely covenant to warrant and Defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever And the said Sarah Houtz, wife of the said Leonard Houtz does hereby relinquish her Rights of Dower in and to the above described premises In Witness where above have hereunto set our hands and Seals this Eleventh day of February AD 1863.....

The plat map for this cemetery is on file in the **Muscatine County Record of Lands, Book Z** on pages 582 and 583. It is titled: **High Prairie Cemetery 1st M.E. Church.** It was located on Lord's Ferry road in Seventy-Six Township. The description of the plat is as follows:

High Prairie Cemetery Commencing Thirty feet North from the S.E. corner of the W ½ of the N.E. ¼ of Sec. 4 Township 76 M R3 West: thence North Two hundred feet, thence West one hundred & eight nine feet: Thence South two hundred feet Thence West one hundred & eighty nine feet: Thence South two hundred feet, Thence East one hundred & eighty nine feet to beginning and laid out into Cemetery lots running N & S. E & W. Streets & Alleys all marked as exhibited on the within plat. Course and distance given on the line. Scale 20 feet to an Inch. Surveyed March 3, 1864 by G. Bumgardner Sur.

Be it remembered that on the Fifth day of March A.D. 1864 before the undersigned county Judge of said County personally appeared before me. George Bumgardner, Thomas Bowlby, Wm. H Miller, W. H. Helm & John Fletcher who acknowledge as Trustees of the Methodist Episcopal Church at High Prairie Chapel in Lake Township Muscatine County, Iowa that the dissasation of the above land as shown

by the map is with their free consent and in accordance with their desire. In testimony where of the said Trustees have hereunto subscribed their names....

Few members of the High Prairie Methodist Church had any knowledge as to the origins of this cemetery. There was an entry in the High Prairie Church Cemetery Lot Owner book that pertained to money spent for a fence repair in 1910 at the Houtz Cemetery. No records have been found of the cemetery management, Lot Owners or burials. The only information that is known was taken from grave markers that had dates that ranged from 1850 to 1902.

Found in obituaries of those interred here, this cemetery has been referenced as Houtz cemetery, Bowlby cemetery or just as "the family cemetery". In the WPA listings the burials were said to be at the Vannatti Cemetery, in Cranston, 76 Twp.

Today the Seventy-Six Township Trustees of Muscatine County are responsible for maintaining the grounds. No new burials are accepted.


