scription is possible so long as the material was boxed and laid away in the rear of the store. Now when all is in place and the job finished the result is a beautiful piece of work.

This is the first galvanized iron front to be put up in Tipton, but we have our doubts about its being by any means the last. The work of putting it in place occupied about a week. The old brick front, which was good in its day, was taken down, the windows moved back to protect the store, and the work of putting in the foundation stones begun. These were three in number and were splendid specimens of Joliet stone, cut by Comstock and put in place by Ed. Godden. The work is a great credit to those who fitted them for the building's use. The one forming the sill course being as fine a piece of work as one usually sees. The iron columns which form the window and door frames were next put in place. Then the galvanized work was begun. This was under the supervision of Jas. Horsburg, assisted by Hecht & Diehl, when it came to the tin work. This part of the work is very showy. There are three windows above between which and at the sides are double columns of the Corinthian order.

The whole is surmounted by an elaborate cornice, in the center of which in bold letters is the name "Cobb."

The most principal part and by no means the least valuable is the display window, and the entrance. This latter is on the east side and consists of a single door approached by the sill course above mentioned. This leaves room for a display window 13½ x 5. In the front of this are two panes of plate glass each 63x128 inches; at the side is a glass 51x128 inches, giving a total frontage for display purposes of almost 15 feet. These glass were put in place by Ingman & Son, who completed the delicate and difficult job without mishap. The total height of the front is 32 feet, the width 20 feet. All of the iron work has been finished by Ingman & Son to resemble light Joliet stone, the wood work being done in black. The iron work came from Mesker Bros., St. Louis; the glass from Geo. F. Kimble, Chicago; and the rest of the work and

STANTON—On Sunday, July 26th, 1891, at his residence near Bennett, Mr. John W. Stanton, in the seventy-fifth year of his age.

Mr. Stanton was born in Charleston, Montgomery county, N. Y. In 1837 he married Miss Rachel, youngest daughter of the late Deacon Isaac Burnap, of the same place; both united with the Christian church, and were ever identified with that denomination.

In 1857 Mr. Stanton came with his family to Cedar county, where he has since resided.

Their widowed daughter soon died, leaving a little girl who knew no other parents than father and mother Stanton. Mrs. Stanton died Oct. 12th, 1878. Another daughter, Mrs. A. G. Downing, of Des Moines, and one son, N. B. Stanton, of California, survive.


Oct. 15th, 1879, Mr. Stanton married Miss Caroline D. Kimmann, who tenderly cared for him to the last, and is left with their daughters Electa, ten years of age, and Hannah L., an infant.

Politically Mr. Stanton was a staunch republican, who served his party well in minor offices, as well as in the legislature of 1864.

"When a few years are come, then I shall go the way whence I shall not return." From this subject Rev. Dyre of the M. E. Church preached an impressive sermon to a large and sympathetic audience which had assembled to pay a last tribute of respect to our friend, whom we all believe died in Jesus.
