



John Dale will conduct the 2 p. m. service from the Osceola Christian Church with interment in the Van Wert cemetery.

Saylor Feed Company, located at 117 East Washington, Osceola, and founded by Ernest Saylor, will be closed all day Tuesday in observance of the services.

Ernest B. Saylor was born July 30, 1884, in Bondurant, Polk County, Iowa, son of Lawrence Saylor and Nettie Belle Scott Saylor. He attended school in Des Moines. On February 25, 1906, he was married to Elsie Mae Hall in Van Wert. One son was born to this union. He was married to Marguerite Fischback on May 2, 1938, in Osceola.

He engaged in farming in the Van Wert area in 1900 and later went into the feed and grain business. He was elected to the Iowa House of Representatives for the 51st general assembly. He was a former Rotarian, Honorary Member of the F.F.A. and a member of the Osceola Christian Church.




